RE: Study leave

During the last two weeks students have been completing their GCSE exams. Students have responded extremely well to the expectations in terms of preparation as well as behaviour in the exams themselves.

A number of students and parents/carers have asked for clarity around study leave. We have discussed this as a leadership team and would like to confirm that study leave will begin for students from Monday 13th June, 2022. Students will not be expected to come into school unless they have an exam.

For a morning exam (9:00am), students must be in the restaurant for an 8:30am start; for an afternoon exam (1:30pm) students must be in the restaurant for a 12:15pm start. From Monday 13th June, students **must** sign in and out at reception. This is extremely important so we can continue to safeguard students.

We will continue to offer targeted revision sessions ahead of each exam, as set out in the document you received by email. Likewise, students can still attend normal lessons, stated on their timetable. All year 11 teachers will still be available during normal Year 11 timetabled lessons. Whilst in school, normal expectations of behaviour and uniform still apply to students.

Students can still use school transport to and from school, as normal. However, we will not be running any transport in addition to this. If students wish to leave school site after an exam, they will have to arrange alternative transport.

We hope by offering this opportunity students can target their revision to enable them to achieve the best possible results.
